

HONG KONG OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH AWARD 2005

Encouraging results were again achieved at the Hong Kong Occupational Safety and Health Award Forum 2005 which was officiated by Mr. Stephen Ip, GBS, JP, Secretary for Economic Development and Labour on 6th June 2005. Two prestigious awards were scored despite the very keen competition among the 29 finalists short-listed from a total of 148 entries from 79 local utilities and reputable organizations. The awards scored was the Gold Award in Safety Management System and the Silver Award in Best Presentation. This year, this annual promotional event was jointly organized by the Occupational Safety & Health Council, the Labour Department and eleven other prestigious local organizations.

Hongkong Electric's paper, titled Safety Management System Based Approach for Integrated Environmental, Quality, Health and Safety (EQHS) Management System for Power Transmission and Distribution Activities, highlighted the development and implementation of its Integrated Management System (which embraced the management systems for environment, quality, health and safety). Our achievements in further enhancing the performance of EQHS aspects as well as uplifting morale and productivity of our employees were also highlighted to the Judge Panel. The paper was presented in the form of a drama by a group of employees. Both the paper and the drama were well received by the Judge Panel and the audience. The two Awards scored were presented to Hongkong Electric by Mr. Fred Ting, JP, Deputy Commissioner for Labour (Occupational Safety and Health) and Mr. Lee Kai Ming, SBS, JP, Vice Chairman of Occupational Safety & Health Council respectively.
