

## **2007 HONG KONG OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH AWARD FORUM**

Riding on the very encouraging results achieved in 2006, HK Electric scored two more prestigious awards, the Gold Award in Safety Technological Achievement and Bronze Award in Safety Management System Award – Others at the 2007 Hong Kong Occupational Safety & Health Award Forum and Award Presentation Ceremony on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2007 despite the very keen competition among the 28 finalists short-listed from a total of around 200 entries from 95 local utilities and reputable organizations.

This year, the above annual safety promotional event, which was jointly organized by the Occupational Safety & Health Council, the Labour Department and eleven other prestigious local organizations, was officiated by Mr. Matthew Cheung Kin Chung, GBS, JP, Secretary for Labour and Welfare.

Two papers from HK Electric were shortlisted to be the finalists of the Forum.

The paper titled "New 22kV Electricity Distribution System with Enhanced Occupational Health and Safety Designs", highlighted the use of 22kV electricity distribution system to ensure/enhance site safety in power delivery business, scored the Gold Award in Safety Technological Achievement. This is the fifth time that HK Electric scored the Gold Awards in this territory-wide annual safety promotion event in recent seven years.

Another paper titled "Natural Gas Safety Management System", which detailed the natural gas safety management system for a natural-gas-fired combined-cycle generation unit newly installed in Lamma Power Station, also earned Bronze Award in the Safety Management System Award – Others.
